Carbon Literacy: Responding to Climate Crisis is **an awareness of the carbon impacts of our everyday activities, and the ability and motivation to reduce emissions on an individual, community and organisational basis.**

Founded in 2012, the [Carbon Literacy Project](#) was set up with the intention to allow every person who works, lives or studies in Manchester to receive access to a full day of Carbon Literacy training.

Yes! We have a range of training options that are suitable for all individuals, SMEs, organisations and businesses.

What are the costs?

The costs vary depending on the type of training you'd like to partake in. Read on to find out more and select the best package for you and your team.

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Where does the training take place?

There are a several options. You can come to us or we can come to you! HOME is Manchester's leading venue for film, theatre, performance and visual art. We are based in Manchester City Centre on 1st Street, just off Whitworth Street West.

Our award-winning building is the perfect site for a day of training, and we look forward to welcoming you. Alternatively, we can come to your venue and deliver the training to your team on-site.

What does the training entail?

Over the last three years, we've developed an engaging and interactive training package that is inclusive to all employee levels.

The training comprises two parts:

Part 1) Film Screening: An introduction to climate change and global impact

Part 2) Workshop: Knowledge, awareness and action planning

At the end of the training day you will complete a participant action form that is sent to the Carbon Literacy Project for certification.

On receipt of certification, you will become Carbon Literate.

Who are the trainers?

HOME has two dedicated certified Carbon Literacy trainers, with several years of Carbon Literacy training experience and a wealth of knowledge and expertise in environmental sustainability, operations, policy development, action planning and project management.

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Training Packages

We offer four types of training package ranging from in-house delivery to bespoke tailor-made packages for your team. Read on to find the best option for you.

1) Full day training at HOME

This option allows your team to complete their full training in one day across our fantastic spaces at HOME

2) Half day training completing Part 2) Workshop at your business/organisation

This option requires you to deliver Part 1) Film Screening, prior to our trainers delivering Part 2) Workshop at your workplace. We will provide you with a copy of the film in advance of the workshop. It is essential for your team to complete Part 1) Film Screening before attending Part 2) Workshop. Failure to do so will result in lack of certification.

3) Half Day Training completing Part 2) Workshop at HOME as part of a smaller group

This option is available to SMEs and individuals who want to complete training but do not meet the maximum 16 capacity of participants. A maximum of 4 attendees from your business/organisation may attend.

You will be invited to complete Part 2) Workshop at HOME with new starters from HOME and/or other SMEs and Individuals. This option is particularly beneficial for those in sustainability roles who are looking to advocate their environmental agenda and grow in confidence in their role, returning to your employer with the skills and actions to support your organisation's policies, practices and ambitions.

We will provide you with a copy of the film in advance of the workshop. It is essential for you to complete Part 1) Film Screening before attending the Part 2) Workshop. Failure to do so will result in lack of certification.

4) Train the Trainer and a bespoke Carbon Literate Training package
